LOCATION: Kamehameha Highway between Middle Street and Laumaka Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

Alternating lanes of eastbound and westbound Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Kamehameha Highway between Laumaka Street and Puuhale Road

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

Alternating lanes of eastbound and westbound Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Puuhale Road Intersection

Nighttime: 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnight Tuesday to Wednesday

Intersection will be partially closed. On-site flaggers and on-site personnel will be assisting with maintaining traffic.

IWILEI

LOCATION: Dillingham Boulevard between Alakawa Street and Kaaahi Street

Nighttime: 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Tuesday to Friday

The eastbound lanes of Dillingham Boulevard will be reduced to one lane. Bus stops may be closed or relocated when necessary.

Nighttime: 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Tuesday to Friday

The westbound lanes of Dillingham Boulevard will be reduced to one lane. Special-duty officers will assist with traffic movements as needed.

LOCATION: Kaaahi Street between Dillingham Boulevard and Kaaahi Place
