KALIHI

Sunday, November 4, 2018 to Saturday, November 10, 2018

LOCATION: Kamehameha Highway between Middle Street and Laumaka Street Intersection

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday to Friday

Two eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed. Bus stop will be relocated as needed. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

LOCATION: Dillingham Boulevard between McNeill Street and Kohou Street

Nighttime: 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Monday to Friday

Up to two alternating eastbound lanes of Dillingham Boulevard will be closed.

IWILEI

Sunday, November 4, 2018 to Saturday, November 10, 2018

LOCATION: Dillingham Boulevard between Kohou Street and Alakawa Street

Nighttime: 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Monday to Friday

The inside eastbound lane of Dillingham Boulevard will be closed.

Nighttime: 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Monday to Friday

The left-turn lane from eastbound Dillingham Boulevard into the Honolulu Community College driveway at Alakawa Street will be closed.

LOCATION: Dillingham Boulevard between Alakawa Street and Kaaahi Street

Nighttime: 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Monday to Friday

The eastbound and westbound lanes of Dillingham Boulevard will be closed. Eastbound traffic will be contraflowed. Bus stops will be relocated when necessary. Pedestrian access will be maintained. Special duty police officers and/or flaggers will be in place to assist traffic flow.

Nighttime: 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Monday to Friday

The left-turn lane from westbound Dillingham Boulevard into the COSTCO parking lot will be intermittently closed. Motorists will be detoured to Alakawa Street.
