LOCATION: Kamehameha Highway Middle Street to Laumaka Street Intersection

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

One eastbound lane may be closed and two eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway may be shifted. Bus stop will be relocated as needed. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

IWILEI

Tuesday, January 22, 2019 to Friday, January 25, 2019

LOCATION: Kaaahi Street between Dillingham Boulevard and Kaaahi Place

Daytime: 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

No on-street parking will be allowed. Eastbound and westbound travel lanes may be shifted to accommodate two-way traffic.

KAKAAKO

Tuesday, January 22, 2019 to Friday, January 25, 2019

LOCATION: Queen Street between Ward Avenue and Kamakee Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

Eastbound and westbound travel lanes on Queen Street may be shifted.

LOCATION: Kamakee Street between Kawaihao Street and Auahi Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

The southbound outside lane on Kamakee Street may be closed.

LOCATION: Queen Street between Kamakee Street and Pensacola Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

One lane for both eastbound and westbound on Queen Street may be closed.

LOCATION: Waimanu Street between Kamakee Street and Queen Street

Daytime: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

No on street parking may be allowed. Eastbound and westbound travel lanes on Waimanu Street may be shifted.

LOCATION: Kona Street between Pensacola Street and Piikoi Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

Eastbound and westbound travel lanes on Kona Street may be closed.

LOCATION: Pensacola Street between Hopaka Street and Waimanu Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

The right lane on Pensacola Street near the Kona Street Intersection may be closed.
