

This is to inform you that the contractor for the West Oahu/Farrington Highway (WOFH) Guideway Project, Kiewit Infrastructure West Company (KIWC), plans to pursue an existing casting yard to fabricate the pre-cast guideway elements. Attached is a copy of KIWC's letter informing the City of its decision.

By using an existing casting yard, the WOFH project should not cause new or different environmental impacts from those already disclosed in the Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the subject project. 
Dear Mr. Hamayasu,

This is to inform you that Kiewit Infrastructure West Company (KIWC) has determined to pursue an alternative precast yard site or facility.

We plan to pursue an existing precast yard or facility on Oahu, so as not to introduce any new or different impacts from what is identified in the Final Environmental Impact Statement for the Honolulu High-Capacity Transit Corridor Project. Due diligence investigations have begun for existing sites and facilities that have been previously used and permitted for precast operations. It will also include an evaluation of transportation routes, schedule, storage, financial analysis, and other logistics.
