

## TRAFFIC UPDATE – City Center

### Week of June 7, 2020

*There will be no travel lane closures on Thursday, June 11, 2020 in observance of King Kamehameha Day, except where noted below. All 24/7 lane closures will remain in place during this time.*

#### KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY

**Sunday, June 7, 2020 to Saturday, June 13, 2020**

##### LOCATION: Middle Street to Puuhale Road

**24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week**

Traffic will be reduced to one westbound travel lane and one eastbound travel lane beginning at the H-1 eastbound off-ramp. Left turns on Kamehameha Highway will be restricted. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

#### DILLINGHAM BOULEVARD

**Sunday, June 7, 2020 to Saturday, June 13, 2020**

##### LOCATION: Puuhale Road to Mokauea Street

**24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week**

Traffic will be reduced to one westbound travel lane and one eastbound travel lane. Left turns on Dillingham Boulevard will be restricted. The sidewalk adjacent to the eastbound lanes of Dillingham Boulevard between Puuhale Street and Mokauea Street will be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured to the opposite sidewalk.

##### LOCATION: Mokauea Street to Kalihi Street

**24 Hours a Day: From 6:00 a.m. Sunday through 6:00 p.m. Saturday**

No on-street parking will be allowed. Eastbound and westbound travel lanes may be shifted to accommodate two-way traffic.

Alternating lanes of Kamakee Street will be closed in the makai direction.

**KONA STREET**

**LOCATION: Pensacola Street and Piikoi Street**

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Friday**

Alternating lanes of Kona Street may be closed between Pensacola Street and Piikoi Street.

**LOCATION: Piikoi Street and Keeaumoku Street**

**Daytime: 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday**

Alternating lanes of Kona Street may be closed between Piikoi Street and Keeaumoku Street. Detours will be in place as needed to provide access.

## **PIIKOI STREET**

**Sunday, June 7, 2020 to Saturday, June 13, 2020**

**LOCATION: Kapiolani Boulevard and Ala Moana Boulevard**

**Daytime: 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Sunday to Saturday morning**

Intermittent lane closures in both the mauka and makai bound lanes. The Kona Street crosswalk may be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured. On-street parking may be restricted on Piikoi Street.

**Noise Impact: During potholing, vac truck, drilling and excavation work, expect increased noise levels from the unloading of materials and general machinery sounds.** *Shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road will mark the work area. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and provide a safe distance between their vehicles, the construction workers and equipment.*
