

TRAFFIC UPDATE - Farrington Highway

Week of June 7, 2020

There will be no travel lane closures on Thursday, June 11, 2020 in observance of King Kamehameha Day, except where noted below. All 24/7 lane closures will remain in place during this time.

KAPOLEI

Sunday, June 7, 2020 to Saturday, June 13, 2020

LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway at Keahumoa Parkway

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The shoulder lane of westbound Keahumoa Parkway will be closed between Kualaka'i Parkway and Maunakapu Street. A portion of the sidewalk along the northbound lanes of Kualaka'i Parkway will be closed at the Keahumoa Parkway intersection. Detours will be in place for pedestrians.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Wednesday, and Friday

Alternating lanes of westbound Keahumoa Parkway will be closed between Kualaka'i Parkway and Maunakapu Street.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Wednesday, and Friday

Alternating lanes of eastbound Keahumoa Parkway will be closed between Kualaka'i Parkway and Maunakapu Street.

LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway between Keahumoa Parkway and Farrington Highway

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Wednesday, and Friday

Alternating lanes of northbound Kualaka'i Parkway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Wednesday, and Friday

Alternating lanes of southbound Kualaka'i Parkway will be closed.

LOCATION: Farrington Highway from the Kualaka'i Parkway intersection to Old Fort Weaver Road

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Wednesday, and Friday

One lane of Farrington Highway may be closed. Eastbound and westbound traffic on Farrington Highway will be maintained through the remaining travel lane, via flagger control.

Shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road will mark the work area. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and provide a safe distance between themselves, the construction workers and vehicles. *Lane closures are subject to change.

Note: Due to overhead crane work, traffic may be stopped intermittently due to safety for commuters and pedestrians.

All lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed. The sidewalk along the westbound lanes of Farrington Highway may be closed. Motorists will be detoured through Hikimoe Street.

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.
