

FARRINGTON HIGHWAY LANE CLOSURES

EASTBOUND/WESTBOUND BETWEEN WAIPAHU DEPOT STREET TO MOKUOLA STREET

Monday-Friday (Some Weekends) 6am-3:30pm

Extension of work: Through September 2020



Hawaiian Dredging Construction Company, Inc. (HDCC) and the Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) will be closing single lanes of traffic on Farrington Highway, in both eastbound and westbound directions, between Waipahu Depot Street and Mokuola Street. These closures are required to safely facilitate completion of overhead canopy construction at the Pouhala (Waipahu Transit Center) station and are expected to continue on weekdays from 6am to 3:30pm through the month of September. Some additional weekend work may be required.

Business and residential driveway access will be maintained. Onsite personnel will assist vehicles and pedestrians around work zones. Intermittent weekend and extended daytime single lane closures will continue as canopy work is completed. Please observe signs and drive slowly in construction zones.
