### TRAFFIC PLANS

- Beginning Friday, September 18, 2020, Nimitz Highway, between Ke'ehi Lagoon Memorial Park and Kahauiki Village, will be closed overnight between the hours of 8 PM and 5 AM for the installation of the overhead rail guideway.
- For safety purposes, a full closure of this quarter-mile stretch is required. Work on this section of Nimitz Highway will continue through November 25, 2020.
- Motorists traveling eastbound wanting to continue onto Nimitz Highway will be detoured to the Kamehameha Highway/Dillingham Boulevard exit and Kalihi Street to return to Nimitz Highway eastbound.
- Pedestrian and vehicle access to Ke'ehi Lagoon Memorial Park and Kahauiki Village will be maintained.

## NIGHT WORK

The Department of Health has approved a variance for Community Noise Control for night work activities related to the Airport Guideway and Stations segment of the Honolulu Rail Transit Project.

Standard construction equipment, such as bulldozers, excavators, soil augers, backhoes, graders, pavers, mixers, trucks, cranes, saws, generators, compressors and pumps, shall be allowed 24 hours a day during project construction.

Light impact equipment, such as jackhammers, pavement saws and pavement breakers, will be limited to specific night hours in accordance with DOH's approved variance.
