

LANE CLOSURE NOTICE

NIMITZ HIGHWAY AND VALKENBURGH STREET

ONGOING THROUGH DECEMBER 2020

SUNDAY TO THURSDAY | OVERNIGHT: 8 PM TO 5 AM

Construction activities on the Honolulu Rail Transit Project will continue through December 2020. Work on the overhead guideway and the roadway will occur as needed from Sunday through Thursday, between 8 PM and 5 AM. Motorists are advised of the following intermittent lane closures and detours associated with this work.

TRAFFIC PLANS

Phase 1: Valkenburgh Street


All left turns at the Nimitz Highway/Valkenburgh Street intersection will be closed. Through traffic on Valkenburgh Street will also be closed. Travel on Nimitz Highway westbound and eastbound will be maintained.

Mauka Access: The left turn from Nimitz Highway eastbound onto Valkenburgh Street (mauka) will also be closed. Motorists wanting to access Valkenburgh Street (mauka), as well as Nimitz Highway westbound, the H-1 Freeway westbound, and Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam will be detoured to Catlin Drive for a U-turn.

Motorists heading mauka-bound on Valkenburgh Street and approaching the Nimitz Highway intersection will be detoured eastbound to Catlin Drive for a U-turn.

Makai Access: Motorists traveling makai-bound on Valkenburgh Street approaching the Nimitz Highway intersection will be detoured westbound to Center Drive, then Radford Drive to return to Nimitz Highway eastbound to access Valkenburgh Street (makai).

The left turn from Nimitz Highway westbound onto Valkenburgh Street (makai) will be closed. Motorists will be detoured onto Kamehameha Highway westbound, then to Center Drive, Radford Drive and Kamehameha Highway eastbound, to return to Nimitz Highway.




Phase 2: Nimitz Highway

Nimitz Highway eastbound may be closed between Valkenburgh Street and Main Street.

Motorists traveling on Nimitz Highway eastbound will be detoured onto Valkenburgh Street makai and then to Main Street to return to Nimitz Highway eastbound.

Valkenburgh Street is open to two-way traffic through the intersection. Motorists wanting to access Nimitz Highway westbound, the H-1 Freeway westbound, and Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam will be able to turn left.



For safety, pedestrians will be detoured around the project area. Bus stops will be relocated. For bus information, visit www.TheBus.org or call (808) 848-5555. For real-time bus arrivals, visit hea.thebus.org.
