


# CITY CENTER UTILITIES RELOCATION STREET AND SIDEWALK CLOSURE NOTICE

## Nimitz Highway Off-Ramp to Iwilei Road

Estimated Start: Late October 2020 | Daily 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. for approximately 6 months

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) and Nan, Inc. would like to notify area residents and businesses of a full closure of the Nimitz Highway off-ramp to Iwilei Road which includes the sidewalk. Detours will be in place. This is in addition to the ongoing traffic controls in the area. These traffic controls are required to safely relocate utilities for the Honolulu Rail Transit Project. For those living and working close to the work zone, please pardon the inconvenience. This area may experience an increase in traffic and noise levels.

### TRAFFIC PLANS

- The Nimitz Highway off-ramp to Iwilei Road will be closed.
- Detour route: Nimitz Highway to Sumner Street to Iwilei Road.
- The sidewalk will also be closed with a pedestrian detour to King Street via River Street.
- On-site special duty officers/flaggers will assist pedestrians and commuters as needed.
- For safety, please observe posted speed limits, traffic directional signs, and/or special instructions.
