Lorenzo – I am trying to respond to an inquiry from Region 9 regarding Kiewit's precast yard. I have two questions:

- Did PB develop a separate engineers estimate for development of a precast yard? My assumption is they did not since they would not have known whether the selected contractor would be using an existing facility or developing a new facility. In my experience, we always incorporated those costs into the unit price estimates. Can you confirm this is the case here? [Yes, the GEC incorporated the casting activity costs, which included all costs for setting up the yard as well as casting all of the segments, into the unit price estimates.]
- It looks like costs for the precast yard may be spread out over a few line items (P106B Site Preparation and A1020 Mobilization). Can you confirm? [Yes, the costs are spread out over several items, including the activities for erecting the segments.]
