Mauka/makai views are blocked which is a violation of a 1990's city ordinance protecting views. She will be looking into this.

Note: I remember the ordinance which was introduced by then Council Chair Gary Gill. It had to do with public viewing areas like Ala Moana Park, not from resident's lanais or windows. That was the intent.
