On May 7, 2010, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published a notice of availability for the Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for Honolulu High-Capacity Transit Corridor Project, Provide High-Capacity Transit Service on O'ahu from Kapolei to the University of Hawaii at Manoa and Waikiki, City and County of Honolulu, Hawaii (EIS number 20100230). The project title reflected a more extensive study area, used for the Draft EIS, which is no longer applicable to the project. Therefore, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) is requesting that the EPA publishes a correction notice with a revised project title: Honolulu High-Capacity Transit Corridor Project, Provide High-Capacity Transit Service on O'ahu from University of Hawai'i-West O'ahu to the Ala Moana Center.

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) would also like to extend the announced 30-day comment period by 20 days. The extended comment period would end on Monday, August 16, 2010.
