I apologize for the unorganized email – but I wanted to make sure that you had these letters. Some of these I may have already sent you. I may have sent a couple to you prematurely without comments. Please bear with me.

For the Kido and Sierra Club letters, There are a few items that need to be addressed or improved upon:

- Kido: Noise, Agri. Mitigation, and the 3% less energy remark (this point needs to be clarified b/c it is found in all of my letters; the statement that the Project will require 3% less energy is not quantified (emissions)...so how do they have that number?).
- Sierra Club: Agri. Mitigation and Air Quality (offset and mitigation comment).

For both of these letters please ensure that you are not providing the suggestion that you are including all energy usage when not factoring in construction related energy.

In places where we have felt like our comments have been addressed, we should have deleted the comment and accepted track changes. I saw one letter that it wasn't the case. Just flag areas where you have questions.
