I just returned a call from Ed Kussy on Honolulu. Based on that call, I don't believe that my response to Honolulu's concerns about my comments (see my response attached) has yet been sent. I think that Honolulu should hear something back soon (even if it isn't the attached) so that their concerns can be somewhat alleviated.

Ed also suggested a call between him, you and I, PB, and Honolulu's environmental attorney on Section 4(f) issues. I'm fine with participating in that discussion, but I think it would be far more productive if they had what I put in the attached in advance of the meeting to narrow the discussion to only remaining issues.
