Aloha Nancy:

Thank you for your 19 March 2010 review letter (LOG NO: 2010.0455 DOC NO: 1003NM50) for the draft archaeological inventory survey (AIS) report for the HHCTCP construction phase I (Hammatt 2010). Your review letter had several comments and requested several revisions to the draft document. These requested revisions have been made and, by copy of this email, I am submitting to SHPD the revised draft AIS report for SHPD's review. Your review letter asked for the following revisions/clarifications:

- 1) Throughout the document the AIS study area and the project area are consistently described as a 7.4 linear mile corridor comprised of all 6.8 linear miles of construction phase I and 0.6 linear miles of the westernmost portion of construction phase II (See pages i, 1, and 121).
- 2) Throughout the document the distinction between the 57 backhoe test trenches and the 35 backhoe excavated, 2 by 2 meter, column location test pits (together totaling 92 test excavations) is clarified with following wording changes: the backhoe trenches are referred to as "backhoe trenches" or "trenches," the column excavations are referred to as "column tests" or "column test pits," and the more generic terms "test excavations" or "excavations" are used when both backhoe trenches and column test pits are being discussed together.
- 3) The mitigation recommendation for SIHP # 50-80-09-7751, subsurface agricultural sediment, has been changed from an archaeological monitoring program to a data recovery program (see page 431).
