Hello Carl,

Just returned from vacation and read your email message. I will ask Deb Roth to send you our writeup on the airport impacts and costs associated with the Aolele Street alignment. We should have this info to you by the end of the week if not earlier.

One concern I have is that until a new alignment is taken, the FAA made a commitment to review an application for in pavement approach lighting system for Runway 4R. As mentioned at the meeting on March 17, 2010, we have no knowledge of this being done anywhere in the USA. The C&C consultant agreed to forward an application with additional information for our review. We agreed to review asap and be able to report out our status in 2 weeks. It has now been 3 weeks and we have not received an application. I would like to send Toru a reminder - thoughts?
