Elaine:

FTA shares those concerns. At this point, the City has not made a decision on whether or not to pursue an alternate alignment. I have included an alignment alternative from the AFEIS that was developed as a 4(f) avoidance alternative. The attachment is for illustrative purposes only. There are a couple of other alternatives under review at this time. We do not know which way the City will go.

Any alternative alignment will have to be reviewed for 106 purposes. Of course the Draft 106 agreement has not been signed, and we believe that no significant modifications can be made by the Signatories. Also, after signing, the agreement can be reopened any time for amendment with Signatory concurrence.

Elaine:

If I counted correctly, we had 11 meetings where all of the consulting parties were invited to attend and reached consensus on a draft final document.

The three Signatories, whose responsibility it is to carry out the provisions of the document, have circulated the document internally and tweaked the draft final language. The document has undergone legal sufficiency review from each of the agencies. There have been no substantive changes in the document since you last saw it, with the exception that the Navy has decided to become a Concurring Party. The Signatories intend to meet early next week to make final modifications and wrap-up the agreement.

We understand the delicate nature of NPS relationship with the Hawaii SHPD, and are including the Draft Final 106 Agreement for NPS review.
