Elaine:

If I counted correctly, we had 11 meetings where all of the consulting parties were invited to attend and reached consensus on a draft final document.

The three Signatories, whose responsibility it is to carry out the provisions of the document, have circulated the document internally and tweaked the draft final language. The document has undergone legal sufficiency review from each of the agencies. There have been no substantive changes in the document since you last saw it, with the

exception that the Navy has decided to become a Concurring Party. The Signatories intend to meet early next week to make final modifications and wrap-up the agreement.

We understand the delicate nature of NPS relationship with the Hawaii SHPD, and are including the Draft Final 106 Agreement for NPS review.
