Hi Carl –

I hope you had a good trip back to DC. It is such a long ways away. We certainly appreciated your coming to Honolulu and meeting with us.

I know that you are busy with other matters related to our project, but I am writing to ask for your assistance in getting the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement moving. I was told by Region IX that Jim Barr has been trying to get a final meeting with all of the signatories. He was unsuccessful in getting the SHPO to commit to a meeting this week and is now attempting to get a meeting scheduled for next week. As I believe I mentioned previously, the SHPO needs to get NPS approval before they can even sign the PA. This means that after the signatories agree on the final PA, there is still the NPS approval process that SHPO needs to get through before it can actually sign the PA. Therefore, all of the delays are adding up. Is there any way that FTA can just tell SHPD and ACHP that this is the final PA and just forget the final meeting? The City would also like to see a copy of the final PA. Any help that you can provide will be greatly appreciated. Thanks.
