You are correct that at least two CZM federal consistency reviews will be necessary for: (1) Department of the Army Permit (Section 404 and/or Section 10); and (2) Federal funding application. If FTA considers itself an active participant in the project, i.e., developer, then FTA will need to submit an application for CZM application for review under the "Federal Agency Activity" category.

Regarding your question about requirements under the CZM Coastal Nonpoint Pollution Control Program, I am forwarding your inquiry to the appropriate person for a response and will get back to you on this.

For the Honolulu High Capacity Transit Corridor Project, we need to verify the number of consistency determinations we need. We are fully aware that we need at least two reviews -- (a) Section 404 CZM review, and (b) Full Funding Grant Agreement CZM review when the project is able to submit the application. The question becomes do we trigger any other CZM review due to federal involvement through FTA participation in the design and approval process (EIS, Letter of No Prejudice, or acquisition of Federal property)?
