The mark-up in circulation was edited by ACHP management. This is subsequent to SHPO, FTA and ACHP staff all marking-up a final draft. The intention is to get FTA management and ACHP management in agreement before requesting concurrence from SHPO management. SHPO has seen the ACHP management mark-up. SHPO will have to run the final by NPS for approval because NPS is currently overseeing certain Hawaii SHPO activities.

The Navy will not be a Signatory because they do not want to disturb City officials with the need to go back to Council for review and re-approval of a significant change to the document. Although, any re-alignment may arguably be a significant change.

City staff were not included in the final Signatory staff mark-up of the Draft PA and to my knowledge have not seen it.
