The City Council authorized the Administration to enter into the Programmatic Agreement (PA) on October 27, 2009. Council Resolution 09-306 CD1 together with a copy of the PA is posted on the City's website at <http://www4.honolulu.gov/docushare/dsweb/Get/Document-93679/RES09-306,%20CD1.pdf>. As you can see, your requested WHEREAS clause stated below is not included in this version.

In the current PA, the Navy is a consulting party identified in the PA; therefore, it may sign the document as a concurring party if it so chooses. However, the City has no objection to including the requested WHEREAS clause in the final document if allowed by the FTA. Please work with Faith Miyamoto of our Rapid Transit Division if you wish to have the clause inserted.

Closing the loop on one thing. When we were discussing this back in December, I mentioned that if the Navy was not going to be allowed to sign on the Programmatic Agreement, there was language in a previous draft of the PA that I would want to see in any final version of the document. I enclose it below for your ready reference. It was found at page 4 of the November 17, 2009 version of the PA, which was the circulating version before we had all our discussions in December about the Navy becoming a signatory.

"WHEREAS, the Project will cross lands controlled or owned by the Federal Government and is subject to an approval of that crossing by the applicable Federal agencies, which may elect to adopt this PA at any time; and"
