Hi Ted –

Just spoke with Pua Aiu about the January 25, 2010 Navy letter regarding the Makalapa Housing Area. She agreed that the letter conveyed the Navy's position that the Makalapa and Little Makalapa Housing are two separate areas. Therefore, the earlier eligibility and effect determinations concurred to by the SHPO stand. There will be no further correspondence from the SHPO.

Pua also related her understanding that the Makalapa Housing area boundary was the final issue that required resolution prior to the execution of the Section 106 PA. The Navy letter has resolved the boundary question and so the Section 106 PA that shows/refers to two Makalapa housing areas is ready for finalization and execution.

The City would appreciate a copy of the PA that is being reviewed for execution.
