This language is too strong and mischaracterizes what is happening:

- The Navy has endorsed early closure on this issue but SHPO concerns may require further consideration, including the possible deletion of the station from the project.

I just got off the phone with the Navy's 106/4(f) lead person and he said working cooperatively with the SHPO and we could have a draft Navy letter to the SHPO for review as early as tomorrow. They think that they can make this happen and ACHP will probably not object. NTHP will object, but so what? Navy is still coordinating with the City. Talk of Pearl Harbor Station deletion is a casual grenade that HRT likes to toss around to truncate the NEPA process and shouldn't be taken seriously
