Thank you for the ICRMP copy. We are using it to prepare preliminary Section 106 eligibility information for FTA and Navy review.

Our initial research has kicked up an inconsistency on describing boundary. We are attempting to follow the HDOT right-of-way line for Kamehameha Highway. The problem comes at Radford Drive. The City's land ownership information (tax maps) appear to indicate that Radford Drive is a State of Hawaii right-of-way with 150 feet of width. I know these are technicalities that you probably don't have to deal with daily, but I was wondering if you know either if our property data is wrong, or if the Navy has selected to include State of Hawaii land within the Makalapa management zone?

Right now, we really aren't sure how we should connect the right-of-way lines north and south of Radford Drive for the eligibility determination for the potential district.
