Hi Faith, There are wording changes that will be transmitted to you when they are finalized. We are not waiting on any action on your part for that negotiation to continue, so don't worry about that. As you have noted you are, you should be focused on the Makalapa issue and working with the Navy and SHPD.

We have no other comments on the FEIS at this time, Renee and Chris can speak to the comments on the response letters, I'm not sure what they told you. Resolution of the airport issue will likely lead to some changes, so as I said in my voicemail for FAA and FTA the ball is really in HDOT's hands now to do their outreach to the air community and develop their positions on future land and runway uses at the airport. Once we have things to a point where all the outstanding issues are resolved we will ask you to submit a complete final draft of the FEIS for our last review.

Just checking if there were any more changes to the Section 106 PA that we needed to incorporate. Earlier we received some comments from Jim Barr, regarding the Navy signatory issue, the Little Makalapa issue, and taking the Salt Lake Alternative off the drawings. We have been discussing the Navy issue with the Navy and SHPD. We have generated one letter to the Navy and one to the SHPO regarding the steps that were followed in determining the boundaries of Makalapa and Little Makalapa. Jim mentioned that there were some wording changes that the signatories worked out. Will you be sending these to us to revise the PA or are you making those changes? Are you waiting on us to make the changes requested before you can schedule your next meeting of the signatories?

Also, any other revisions to the FEIS? Any comments on the DEIS Comment Responses?
