I know you will be in meetings until Wednesday, but I thought if you had some time you may be able to answer a question for me.

We have been discussion historic effects of our project with the National Park Service and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation. One of the comments that we have been getting from them is that they want to see our procurement documents/contracts prior to them being released/executed to make certain that the mitigations we have in our Section 106 agreements are included in the contracts. We have heard that HDOT Director has related that these two entities have tried to attach these provisions to State Highway contracts without success, but that HDOT has been able to get clearance from these two entities despite their efforts. Who can I speak with to confirm HDOT Director's statement?
