Hi Jim, I was off Friday and missed your call, but I saw you sent the reminder email of the things Honolulu needed to follow up on. Looks good. I'm going to send the comments I have today (Saturday) so Faith will have them on her desk first thing Monday.

I'm not available for any meetings next week. But it looks like they are trying to schedule "the" final meeting next Monday.

Renee said she did want to see the final document before FTA would sign it. However, it appears that what Faith is proposing would rush the schedule. If we have one last meeting on the 9th, I would only call it a "final draft" after that. Renee is not going to review anything that is open to change from other parties, so I wouldn't want to give her a draft on the 3rd. Anyway, it's a sort of a moot point, as Renee will be in Honolulu all week with us and will not review it before the 9th anyway.

I would propose we tell Faith to have a meeting on November 9, and IF it goes well and we leave with a final draft from the consultation group, then we give it to Renee. What do you think?

Also, I did discuss next steps with Blythe. We agreed there should be another meeting of the whole group, and if it goes well we can call the consultation process with the larger group completed. She agreed that any small changes in the document could be distributed through email updates. Her opinion was the group seemed amendable to email communications as long as they weren't on substantive matters. Blythe and I also discussed having a "next steps" call with ACHP and FTA after the last consultation group meeting just to make sure ACHP was satisfied and discuss how we close things out.

I will be checking email early Monday morning, but have to leave mid-morning. After that I will just be checking my emails at night. Let me know what you think.

Hi Everyone –

As I related in my email to all of the Section 106 Consulting Parties, we are preparing the “final” version of the PA that addresses all of the comments that have been received. Concurrently, we are finalizing a matrix that includes all of the comments received from Day 1 and how these comments were addressed. It is our intent to have these two documents completed by early next week, at the latest by Tuesday. What is FTA’s position regarding the next step? Should we schedule a meeting for the following Monday, November 9th to go over the PA and for the signatories to make any final statements?

It is my understanding that once you receive the PA on November 3rd, the PA needs to undergo a legal review prior to having the Regional Administrator sign it. However, we would like to go ahead and schedule the November 9th meeting. OK?

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
