Thank you for meeting with me to further discuss Hunt Development's participation in support of the Honolulu Rail Transit Project.


As a follow-up to my letter of May 1, 2008, we discussed the location of a park-and-ride site and the necessity of a pedestrian overpass on North/South Road to serve your development from the future East Kapolei rail station.

I appreciate your understanding that those two facilities are necessary components of the project. Although our initial request was that the park-and-ride facility be located immediately across from the rail station, we agree to reconsider an alternate location in response to your request to do so. We will likely need to adjust the station location so that the alternate parking site would be within a reasonable distance. The project engineers will be assessing the possible adjustment to the station site, and we will inform you if the adjustment is feasible.

I am encouraged by your offer to the Department of Transportation Services to have Hunt and rail project engineers collaborate to conceptually design the pedestrian overpass in order to estimate the cost. I do hope that Hunt Development participates in implementing the obvious safety feature necessitated by the placement of the station across the major highway from your development. Should the station be located within the Hunt development as we had hoped, the major pedestrian activities would be contained as well.
