Subject: Introduction and Project Overview Meeting with UH

Summary:

- Toru gave an overview of the project. Mark indicated that other alternatives besides a fixed guideway for transit are being considered, but for today’s meeting we will focus on various transit alignment alternatives. Clyde then gave a brief summary of the proposed corridor alignment options focusing in on UH West Oahu, Leeward Community College, Honolulu Community College, and UH at Manoa.
- UH-West Oahu’s preference is for the rail alignment to run along Farrington Highway to access their site.
- Leeward Community College also expressed a desire for transit to service their site.
- Honolulu Community College expressed a desire for transit to run along Dillingham Boulevard to service their site, as their main entrance is along Dillingham Boulevard. They would be interested in providing classes to train transit operators. This was in the works during the last rail transit project.
- Alan indicated that very detailed plans for the UH-Manoa quarry station were put together in 1992. They expressed a desire to keep the plans unchanged, as revising them would affect many other plans in the area. The recently constructed parking structure was designed for a pedestrian connection to the station. The pedestrian walkway would be located between the Special Events Arena and the Kahanamoku Pool.
- There is no desire by UH to extend transit up University Avenue to the Metcalf station.
