Subject: Ala Moana Shopping Center Expansion - Nordstrom

Attendees: Jeff Dinsmore and Sharon Thom, GGP; Mits Aruga, AAIA; Dick Page, Wayne Yoshioka and Clyde Shimizu, PB.

The purpose of the meeting was continues coordination with the Ala Moana Shopping Center Expansion.

General Growth Properties, Inc. indicated that the profile of the rail alignment could be lowered from previously requested. They suggested that the bottom of structure be at about elevation 68.0 (top of rail elevation at 78.0). This would be several feet higher than the top of roof of their current expansion.

Summary:

GGP also requested that the platform for the rail system be located on the Ewa side of the proposed shopping center expansion.

PB indicated that transit passengers transferring from buses at ground level would primarily use elevators to transfer to the rail system. This would have been the case whether or not the rail profile remained at elevation 59.0 as in the 1992 study or be raised to elevation 78.0.

Actions Required: PB will find and provide to GGP structural information from the 1992 study. GGP will prepare plans to document that the suggested relocation of the rail station can be accommodated.
