Hi Ted –

We have been getting some comments from the consulting parties that a meeting during the week of October 12<sup>th</sup> will not be good because this is the week of the National Trust for Historic Preservation Conference. Representatives from NTHP and Historic Hawaii Foundation will be attending this conference and will be unavailable to participate in a meeting scheduled for October 14<sup>th</sup>. Blythe will be at the same conference, but she indicated that she would be available on October 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> or 16<sup>th</sup>. We scheduled the "wrap-up" meeting for October 14<sup>th</sup>, in order to allow us to meet certain City Council deadlines and then permit us to proceed with issuing the FEIS. It is my understanding that the FEIS needs to include the programmatic agreement (PA), although it does not need to be executed. The PA needs to be something that is pretty much in final form.

What I wanted to check with you on was whether FTA would agree to stick with the October 14<sup>th</sup> meeting date, although some of the consulting parties would not be able to attend. The signatories and the consulting parties have until the end of Thursday, October 8<sup>th</sup> to provide final comments. By Friday, we should be able to get a good feel for if there are still some areas of disagreement on the PA and how serious these are.

Also, Halealoha of Hui Malama has asked for an acknowledgement from the City regarding his emails on not finalizing the PA until after the AIS work is done. I thought it may be more appropriate for FTA to respond. What do you think?

Let me know if you would like to discuss.
