Subject: Bus pullout on North-South Road

Ken,

If you remember, we met a couple of months ago concerning bus pullouts on North-South Road to serve the East Kapolei Station near the Kroc Center. My understanding is that HDOT would prefer far-side bus stops in pullouts, but that a near-side bus stop in pullout could be acceptable if it was back far enough from the intersection.

The project architects and engineers would like us to consider a near side stop with a pullout in the southbound direction at the East Kapolei station. In that case, how far back from the (future) intersection would the bus pullout need to be?
