Public access to documentation	HHF	Included	The City has committed to place all project-generated historic documentation on the project website and make it available for any other appropriate entity to host.
National Register Nominations	SHPD/ HHF	Included	The City has proposed to complete a number of nominations with specific resources to be determined in coordination with the SHPD. In addition to the individual nominations, the City has proposed a Multiple Property Submission for modern architecture that will assist the SHPD in its evaluation of other modern architecture resources associated with other undertakings. Also, the City will update district nominations for Pearl Harbor (pending Navy agreement) and Chinatown.

Main Street Program (National Trust for Historic Preservation)	HHF	Not Included	Would assist neighborhood-based organizations with revitalization of traditional neighborhood business districts; could provide technical and/or financial assistance to Main Street organizations; program previously existed as a State program; would be a new City program entirely outside of transit project
Restoration of Historic Irwin Park	HHF	Not Included	Project would not have a direct impact on park; park is currently a parking lot under State jurisdiction

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Rehabilitation Fund for Historic Resources	NTHP	Not Included	Would require setting up of fund and rules regarding granting of funds; transit funds could be expended for actions that are not a direct impact of the project, such as rehabilitation of resources not adversely affected by the project; local funding source (GET surcharge \$) limited to paying for construction and operation of system; questionable whether federal funds could be used, subject to FFGA approval
