Met with the SHPD folks yesterday. Mentioned that we would like to have a conference call with the same parties as the previous call (FTA, SHPD, ACHP and RTD, not National Trust for Historic Preservation) to hear FTA's policy/position on Section 106. SHPD is not available today, but would be available tomorrow before 11:00 a.m. Would it be possible to have a conference call maybe about 8:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. Hawaii time? Lawrence has obtained the call in number listed below for the call. Let me know and I can inform everyone; unless you want to do so. National Park Service has been holding separate meetings with the historic preservation partners.
