Hi Russ –

This is a slightly revised version of the letter that we provided to you when we met on July 31, 2009. I believe that we left the meeting with no definitive determination as to who should concur in this determination. The concurrence needs to come from the official(s) with jurisdiction over the resource. Is it the Comptroller? Stadium Authority? DLNR? Who would make this determination for the State? If it is the Authority, would it require Authority action? Can the Authority do this at their next meeting?

Would you suggest that I have this letter finalized and sent to you for you to bring up at the next meeting?

As recommended, I spoke with the Chair of the Aloha Stadium Authority to request that we present an update to the Authority at its next meeting (August 27th). The Chair agreed to put us on the agenda. He said that you have been keeping him informed as to our discussions regarding rail project planning. At our last meeting, you had suggested that we (DAGS and RTD) give the Stadium chair a preview of our presentation to facilitate the presentation. Would you be able to help us schedule this?
