Thank you for your letter of October 29, cosigned by Mr. Jeffrey Berman, commenting on the Honolulu High-Capacity Transit Corridor Project Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) issued in November 2008. In your letter, you express the view that the DEIS does not comply with requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act.

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) issues a DEIS only when it is satisfied that the document complies with National Environmental Policy Act requirements. The public comment period began on November 21, 2008. Due to the high degree of public interest in this project, FTA extended the comment period on the DEIS for 30 days. Additionally, five public hearings on the DEIS were held at local venues during the public comment period. The public comment period closed on February 6, 2009. I have been advised that your association did not formally file comments on the DEIS during the comment period.

FTA received extensive comments on the DEIS. All substantive issues developed in comments on the DEIS will be addressed in the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS). It is my understanding that members of your organization also communicated your concerns to City of Honolulu Department of Transportation Services representatives on October 15, 2009. Please be assured that although your comments were received outside the comment period for the DEIS, your specific issues will be addressed in the FEIS.
