PB brought 3 copies of the current version of the Honolulu FEIS on CDs to the main DOT entrance at 4:30 pm. I gave one copy to Chris and put one on your desk, and I have the other.

At Chris' request, I checked to see if the concurrence by the Hawaii Parks people in the de minimis impact on the memorial park was included. The City's summary of a meeting held on June 2 concludes with the statement that at the meeting DLNR-Parks agreed that the project would not affect the property's recreation activities, features, or attributes.

Subsequently Faith Miyamoto sent an email to Dan Quinn of the Parks Department asking if he had any comments on, or revisions to, the notes of the meeting. He said that the project will require an easement but otherwise the notes were fine.

This will have to constitute the required written concurrence in our finding that the project will not adversely affect the memorial park.
