Points from the meeting:

1. OEQC noted that the Superferry draft Environmental impact Statement is scheduled to be submitted to the OEQC in October 2008;
2. OEQC stated that they will check on if Governor is the accepting party for the document per HRC Chapter 343 (I don't think I got that right – help);
3. OEQC stated that simulations and/or renderings will be helpful for the document. Lawrence stated that PB is currently working on simulations and that there are about 20 being prepared for the draft document;
4. OEQC reminded the project about the importance of having a good section on secondary and cumulative impacts. Lawrence mentioned that the section is more qualitative than quantitative but is being prepared.
5. OEQC stated that projects in the past have had problems with how consulting parties have been notified – PDF versus hard copy. They also mentioned that in the past security locks on PDF documents have been troublesome for the public as they cannot cut and paste for preparing testimony. Lawrence stated that the project has been security coding documents so that the documents cannot be altered. OEQC suggested that the project team poll potential recipient agencies to gauge their preference on how they would like to receive the document;
6. OEQC stated that only the 2005 letters for the EISPIN need to be included in the draft document. Lawrence stated that the comments from these letters have been responded to already.
7. OEQC stated that e-mail responses to comments per the official comment period are acceptable as long as paper copy is kept. For those who do not supply accurate contact information a good faith effort needs to be made to find the individual;
8. OEQC suggested a summarization by chapter of modifications to the draft document. Faith stated that she will need to check with FTA as to their requirements regarding comments and document modifications; and

9. OEQC will check on if PDFs of technical reports can be used instead of hard copies.

Action Items:

1. OEQC
  - a. Check on if Governor is the accepting party for the document per HRC Chapter 343 (I don't think I got that right – help); and
