Hi Jim –

Today, we are sending to you by FedEx ten printed copies of the DEIS for the Honolulu Project; five copies for filing with EPA and five copies for HQ use. Under separate cover, Region IX will be receiving three printed copies and a CD version of the document.

It is our understanding that you will be filing the document for us on Friday, November 14th to have the notice of availability in the November 21st Federal Register. We are also filing the document with the State's Office of Environmental Quality Control to make a notice of availability publication in the November 23rd Environmental Notice. A comment deadline date of January 7, 2009 has been noted in the document to correspond to a 45-day comment period from November 23rd.

Our plans call for us to complete distribution of the DEIS prior to your filing of the document with EPA on Friday. When will you be filing the document?

We have also finalized the public hearing schedule for the document. We will be having public hearings starting on December 6.
