The City shall not move forward with final design for the Pearl Harbor Station until the Keeper of the National Register **has 45 days (or 60 days) to approve or disprove the nomination.** This is the requirement in the regulations. However, what I would recommend is that when preparing the nomination forms we get the views of the National Trust and Historic Hawaii Foundation when submitting the materials to the National Register. There is an appeal process within the regulations where it is not specific how much time the Keeper would have to review nominations and the appeals. If we plan on including their views early on, then it may make the process more efficient.
