All –

I have been in touch with EPA this afternoon. They will make the correction to the FEIS project name and extend the comment period by 20 days. The comment period should end on August 15th. The Office of Federal Activities said that they would be able to publish the information in their notice for this Friday.

The Draft Environmental Impact Statement was titled “Honolulu High-Capacity Transit Corridor Project, Provide High-Capacity Transit Service on O’ahu from Kapolei to the University of Hawaii at Manoa and Waikiki, City and County of Honolulu, O’ahu, Hawaii.” When EPA published the notice they linked the FEIS to the DEIS title already in their database rather than change the name.
