I do have a couple of requests for the authors revising the comments. In addition to content, we also want to make sure that the tone of the responses is neutral, not defensive and clear as possible. Some of the responses to comments were starting to steer toward being defensive. That is not the attitude FTA would like to convey. We also observed that some of the responses back to FTA comments were also defensive in tone. Please try to revise this out of the responses to the public and FTA comments.

Regarding consistency, we understand that some of your consultant staff are working on a consistency check of the entire FEIS. We would like to have your assurance before you give us the camera-ready version of the FEIS that a consistency check has been performed. We are looking for consistent language in 175 of the responses to the DEIS comment letters. Could you give us more information on how you are performing those consistency checks?
