A careful reading of FTA Procedures in the NOI shows that they are doing the standard "Option 2" NEPA Scoping (since they want PE approval after DEIS completion and adoption of the LPA in the Plan) only they are separating the AA from the DEIS. We call this the "funky" option.

Please go ahead and invite me to the meeting. Brigid decided that:

1. they cannot do an AA followed by a DEIS that is essentially the same as the AA. They will need to do a DEIS that is a follow-on to the AA, or do an AA/DEIS. What they want to do (separate but identical AA and DEIS) is not an option.
2. If they decide to go with the AA as a stand-alone document, then after the AA they will have to have a scoping process, in accordance with CEQ regulations, to involve the public and other agencies in deciding the scope of the DEIS.
