FYI: Got this report on the OMPO CAC meeting yesterday. You may find it interesting and I am certain I can name the "representatives".

During yesterday's CAC meeting, opposition to rail was specifically expressed by: League of Women Voters; representatives (some expressing personal opinions) of neighborhood boards #2 (Kuliouou-Kalani Iki), #8 (McCully-Moilili), #9 (Waikiki), and #10 (Makaiki-Tantalus); and the Waikiki Residents Association. Most seemed concerned about construction impacts and loss of viewplanes. ORTP questionnaires received showed the following on rail usage: 7% daily (4-7 times per week); 21% weekly (1-3 times per week); 29% monthly (1-4 times per month); 29% occasionally (1-6 times per year); 7% never; and 7% no response. A separate telephone survey indicated that almost 60% of Oahu residents would use rail rapid transit, with 37% using it on a regular (daily, weekly, or monthly) basis. Forty percent said they would never use it.
