Sending you the November 12, 2010 Council Transportation Committee Agenda. The Section 106 PA is being considered under Resolution 10-305. The original PA attached to the proposed resolution identified the Navy as an invited signatory. A Committee Draft No. 1 will be introduced at the committee meeting that changes the Navy's status to "signatory".
