Lorenzo – We have had a few follow up questions from FTA regarding the precast yard that was the subject of the letter from Kiewit dated December 3. Please let me know if you can answer these at this time or if the information is not yet available:

- What is the location of the facility? [I believe it was said that they are looking at a couple of potential sites, but please confirm.] There are several existing precast facilities on-island; two of which are in the Barbers Point Industrial Area. The two are: GPRM Prestress and Industrial Precast Products (Ameron). Ameron's Kapaa Quarry facility is also a possible precast yard located in Kailua.

- Size of the facility?  
The two existing Barbers Point Industrial Area precast facilities are both approximately 20 acres each.

- Will the facility accommodate all the casting needs for WOFH?  
It is anticipated that the existing facilities will accommodate the precast needs for WOFH.

- Will there be any cost increase to the contract as a result of the selected site?  
The Contractor is responsible for the production of precast elements. We do not anticipate any increase in contract cost as a result of the use of one of the existing precast facilities.

- Any significant pros or cons of the selected site?  
The use of an existing precast facility would not cause new or different impacts not already covered in the Final EIS.
