Good morning, Faith,

Could you or someone on your staff quickly take a look at the attached responses to make sure that my statements are correct? We need this as soon as possible. We had discussed changing the response for the Chinatown Historic District from de minimis to no use. That may have been something that we said we would do. I will check with Chris.

Also, in the email that I first forwarded the NPS comments and subsequent discussions, I requested a schedule in response to the NPS question. We did not need to have a schedule with dates. Instead I would like to have a list of deliverables mentioned in the PA, who would be involved in their review, and what the due dates are in relation to major miles stones (i.e. execution of the PA, prior to final design, prior to construction and so on). At a minimum, could you send the schedule for the first 90 days after execution of the PA that was distributed to the consulting parties.
