Late on Tuesday, the City forwarded FTA a copy of letter that they sent to you dated June 8th. FTA was not consulted by the City in the development of this letter and FTA does not agree with the perspective of the City that the Section 106 consultation process has been concluded. We do not consider consultation under Section 106 to be finalized until the PA is executed. With some outstanding comments made by your office and NPS for FTA to consider and discuss, the PA is in draft form and not ready for signature.
